## THE SACRAMENT OF THE HOLY EUCHARIST:

Truly I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the son of man and drink his blood, you have no life in you (Jn, 6: 53). To respond to this invitation we must prepare ourselves for so great and so holy a moment. St Paul urges us to examine our conscience: 'Whoever therefore eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of profaning the body & blood of the Lord. For anyone who eats and drinks the cup of the Lord without discerning the body eats and drinks judgement upon himself (1 Cor: 11, 27-29).' Anyone conscious of grave sin must receive the sacrament of Reconciliation before coming to communion (CCC1385). To prepare for worthy reception of this Sacrament, the faithful should observe the fast required in their Church. Bodily demeanour (gestures, clothing) ought to convey the respect, solemnity and joy of this moment when Christ becomes our guest (CCC1387).
